

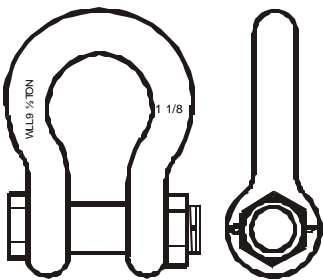

Ministry of Labour (News Releases)

OTTAWA, ON, June 7 / CNW/ - a Halifax, N.S.-based company that supplies and cleans uniforms for various companies, with a plant in Ottawa, was fined \$85,000 today for a violation of the Occupational Health and Safety Act that resulted in a serious leg injury to an employee.

On February 7, 2006, a worker was climbing down from a stainless steel table that was about 79 centimetres (31 inches) off the floor when the worker fell to the floor. The worker had stood on the table to

take down a bag of soiled garments that was hanging on an overhead railed conveyor system. The worker was going to empty the bag and count the number of garments so they could be transported to another part of the plant for cleaning. As a result of the fall, the worker suffered a broken right lower leg.

The company pleaded guilty, as an employer, to failing to ensure the bag was removed in a manner that did not endanger the worker, as required by Section 45(c) of the Regulations for

Industrial Establishments. This was contrary to Section 25 (1)(c) of the act.

The fine was imposed by Justice of the Peace Louise Girault of the Ontario Court of Justice in Ottawa. In addition, the court imposed a 25-per-cent victim fine surcharge, as required by the Provincial Offences Act. The surcharge is credited to a special provincial government fund to assist victims of crime.



Ministry of Labour (News Releases)

TORONTO, May 24 /CNW/ Ont.-based company that sells, installs and maintains industrial-sized overhead doors and related equipment, was fined \$95,000 today for a violation of the Occupational Health and Safety Act that resulted in the death of an employee.

On August 26, 2005, a worker was attempting to repair a "vertical dock leveller" (a steel platform that comes down and acts like a bridge levelling a loading dock when items are being loaded onto or unloaded from

a vehicle) when the 800-kilogram (1,764-pound) leveller fell on the worker. At the time of the incident the worker was bending down at the base of the leveller. The worker died as a result of injuries.

A Ministry of Labour investigation found the leveller was not properly secured or blocked when it fell. The worker was not provided with the manufacturer's procedures on how to safely repair the leveller and had not received any training on how to safely repair vertical dock levellers.

The employer-pleaded guilty, as an employer, to failing to ensure the vertical dock leveller was secured against tipping or falling, as required by Section 46 of the Regulations for Industrial Establishments. This was contrary to Section 25(1) (c) of the act. In addition, the court imposed a 25-per-cent victim fine surcharge, as required by the Provincial Offences Act. The surcharge is credited to a special provincial government fund to assist victims of crime.
